

2017 Edgerton Clean-up Day

Including Appliances

Date: Saturday, May 6 from 8am to 2pm
Location: City Shop on South Mechanic Street

NOT ACCEPTED

1. **MATTRESSES or BOX SPRINGS** (contact VanDyke Sanitation)
2. **TVs, computer monitors, computer CPUs**
3. **Electronics** (other than large appliances)
4. Hazardous materials (MPCA classifies the following as hazardous materials):
 - Batteries
 - Paint, stains, thinner
 - Gas, oil, grease
 - Insecticides, pesticides, etc.
2. Normal household garbage
3. Tires
4. Remodeling & new construction materials
5. Commercial items
6. Cement or cement blocks
7. Trailers needing to be scooped off

CHARGES

Each resident is allowed approximately 3 cubic yards (or one pickup truck bed – level full) at no charge. Heaped loads, trailers and multiple trips accumulative of more than 3 cubic yards will be charged accordingly at **\$20 per 3 cubic yards** additional.

Other charges:

- Carpet and other large items may be charged based on size.

Items MAY NOT be brought to the site before May 6. Individuals that do deliver items before that day will be assessed a fee.

GUIDELINES

1. MPCA Guidelines require that all items must be separated by material type before they are brought to the collections site.
2. Residents must haul their own items to the collection site.
3. Abuse of this service may result in the discontinuation of trash days in future years.

Clean-Up Day service is for residents living within Edgerton city limits only.
