NOT ACCEPTED

- 1. Hazardous materials (MPCA classifies the following as hazardous materials):
 - Batteries
 - Paint, stains, thinner
 - Gas, oil, grease
 - Insecticides, pesticides, etc.
- 2. Normal household garbage
- Tires
- 4. Remodeling & new construction materials
- 5. Commercial items
- 6. Cement or cement blocks
- 7. Trailers needing to be scooped off

CHARGES

Each resident is allowed approximately 3 cubic yards (or one pickup truck bed – level full) at no charge.

Heaped loads, trailers and multiple trips accumulative of more than 3 cubic years will be charged accordingly at \$20 per 3 cubic yards additional.

Other charges collected at drop-off time:

- Mattresses = \$25/each
- Box Springs = \$25/each
- Carpet and other large items may be charged based on size.

Items MAY NOT be brought to the site before May 5.

GUIDELINES

- 1. MPCA Guidelines require that all items must be separated by material type before they are brought to the collections site.
- 2. Residents must haul their own items to the collection site.
- 3. Abuse of this service may result in the discontinuation of trash days in future years.

Clean-Up Day service is for residents living within Edgerton city limits only.
