## **Preparation of Materials**

**Aluminum / Tin:** Food and beverage cans, clean foil, pie pans, and TV dinner trays.

**Glass:** All colors, shapes and sizes of unbroken glass bottles, jars and beverage containers. All caps and rings removed. (NO window glass, drinking glasses, ceramics, light bulbs or dishware.) Glass must be separated by color.

**Plastic:** Check for the following codes on the bottom of the container:

PETE 1 – Containers are plastic pop and liquor bottles.

HDPE 2 – Containers are milk, water, and laundry jugs.

LDPE 4 - Containers are margarine tubs.

PP 5 – Containers are sour cream and ice cream tubs.

**Newspapers:** Dry, clean newspaper and inserts, bagged in brown paper bags or bundled with string. NO phone books.

 $\textbf{Magazines:} \ \textbf{All types of magazines and catalogs}.$ 

NO books or magazines that are not glossy throughout. All magazines must be bundled in brown paper bags or tied in bundles.

**Cardboard:** All colors and type of UNWAXED corrugated cardboard, such as shipping cartons, furniture, and appliance boxes. Cardboard must be flattened and bundled. (brown paper bags can also be bundles with cardboard)

**Office Paper:** Only white paper is acceptable. All paper must be separated into a paper or plastic bag.

• <u>NO</u>: plastic bags, Styrofoam, packaging materials, egg cartons, or dirty items.
